Minimal requirements: To achieve a satisfactory (S) grade in this course, the students are expected to:

- 1. Attend 90% of weekly group meetings. In the event of an unexpected conflict, work with the instructor and other group members to reschedule the meeting(s).
- 2. Deliver a one-hour presentation of their research results or review of research papers relevant to their topic at least once per quarter.
- 3. Read research papers scheduled by presenting group members ahead of time.

- For all presentations, set up the room at least 5 minutes ahead of time so that your group members are not waiting for you. Lock the room after the presentation.
